**TASTING NOTES** The thick, almost impenetrable nose of the 1997 Welschriesling Trockenbeerenauslese Number 7 Zwischen den Seen offers spicy red and white fruit flavors. On the palate, this extraordinarily concentrated, thick, viscous, decadent, and backward wine is densely packed with untold quantities of red, yellow, and white fruits. It coats the palate with layers of honey-dripping fruit flavors that linger for two minutes or more. Drink this gorgeous, sweet wine over the next 12+ years.
