VINIFICATION fermented and matured in big cask for 18 months

TASTING NOTES The 1998 Welschriesling Trockenbeerenauslese Zwischen den Seen Number 6 has a musty (it wasn't corked) nose (from its massive levels of botrytis) that also reveals loads of sweet white and yellow fruits. It is crammed with overripe fruit flavors, as well as the distinctive effects of spicy botrytis. This superbly focused wine has bountiful levels of acidity to cope with its lush, opulently thick character. Drink this refined, liquid botrytis, over the next 20+ years.
