TASTING NOTES The 1998 Traminer Trockenbeereauslese Nouvelle Vague Number 8 is a gold colored wine with an intensely spicy nose. This is a scrumptious wine, packed with white peaches, freshly cracked pepper, apricots, herbs, and botrytis flavors. It is seamless, harmonious, and has the distinctive tannic mark of its varietal in its botrytis-laced finish. Anticipated maturity: now-2025.
