GRAPE VARIETIES 80 % Chardonnay and 20 % Welschriesling

RESIDUAL SUGAR 306,4 g/l

ACIDITY 8,1 g/l

ALCOHOL 7,0 %vol

VINIFICATION fermented and matured in new oak barrels for 18 months

TASTING NOTES Produced from 50% Chardonnay and 50% Welschriesling, Kracher's 1998 Grande Cuvée Trockenbeerenauslese Nouvelle Vague Number 10 reveals hints of sweet oak in its otherwise jammy yellow fruit-dominated aromatics. This medium to full-bodied wine has abundant candied white grapes, and apples intermingled with poached pears in its peppery character. It is thick, spicy, oily-textured, and possesses an amazingly long, apricot-flavored finish. Anticipated maturity: Now-2030.
