GRAPE VARIETIES 60 % Pinot Noir and 40 % Zweigelt

RESIDUAL SUGAR 133,6 g/l

ACIDITY 7,5 g/l

ALCOHOL 13,0 %vol

VINIFICATION fermented and aged in new small oak barrels for 22 months

TASTING NOTES The 1999 #1 Pinot Noir / Zweigelt Nouvelle Vague Trockenbeerenauslese has an amber/bronze color as well as a nose reminiscent of candied strawberries, apricots, and peaches. This sweet, spicy, medium to full-bodied wine offers jellied red and yellow fruit flavors in its oily-textured character. Its tannin-laden (this will resolve in no time) finish reveals caramelized cherries. Projected maturity: Now-2012.
