TASTING NOTES	The 1998 Welschriesling Trockenbeerenauslese Zwischen den Seen Number 11 has a yellow color with golden hues. It exhibits white peach, apricot, smoke, botrytis and freshly cracked white pepper aromas. Medium to full-bodied and elegant, this wine is stuffed with candied kumquats, jellied peaches, spices, and fresh apricots. It has an exceptional combination of refinement, power, and concentration. This decadently-textured wine is intense, pure, and immensely long. Projected maturity: Now-2030+.
