TASTING NOTES	The 1999 #1 Pinot Noir / Zweigelt Nouvelle Vague Trockenbeerenauslese has an amber/bronze color as well as a nose reminiscent of candied strawberries, apricots, and peaches. This sweet, spicy, medium to full-bodied wine offers jellied red and yellow fruit flavors in its oily-textured character. Its tannin-laden (this will resolve in no time) finish reveals caramelized cherries.
