TASTING NOTES	#3 Welschriesling Zwischen den Seen smells of pineapple, must, and sage, with an almost hidden hint of mushroom. Thick and creamy on the palate, yet shot through with bracing citricity, it weaves a relatively noble hint of sauteed mushrooms, even truffle, into its sweet flavors. In the long finish, featuring candied pineapple and sorghum, marrow and mushroom, the fine acids and sheer density successfully buffer the enormous sweetness
